### **TOBY BOZZUTO: BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB AWARD**

President and CEO Toby Bozzuto was honored by the Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Washington at its 18th annual Youth and Real Estate Event in November 2022. He received the Martin K. Alloy Excellence Award, which honors an individual's excellence in their commitment to youth development.



#### **INAUGURAL RISE INITIATIVE WINNER**

Cultivating a culture of kindness and equity is an important aspect of Bozzuto's values. Our efforts to foster inclusivity for our associates led Bozzuto to be recognized in April 2022 as a **Rise Honoree for Bisnow's Inaugural Rise Initiative**. This accolade recognizes companies in the commercial real estate industry that are advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion programs in the workplace.



#### MFE COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

In 2021, Rise by Bozzuto received the Multifamily Executive (MFE) Community Service Award. Bozzuto was one of 13 grand winners chosen out of 300 entries. The MFE Awards demonstrate how Bozzuto continues to leave a worthwhile impact in our communities.



# Rise Highlights

The past year marked an impactful time for Rise and set the bar high for the years ahead. We introduced exciting new partnerships and continued to nurture strong existing ones across our expanding footprint.

# Supporting Ukraine with World Central Kitchen

This campaign raised funds that provided thousands of fresh meals to Ukrainian families and refugees. More than 900 associates and residents came together to raise more than \$98,000, including a \$25,000 match from the Bozzuto Charitable Fund.





# Social & Environmental Impact: Earth Day Volunteer Outing

To celebrate Earth Day, 106 associates from seven of our markets volunteered to get outdoors and clean up their neighborhoods. Tasks included tree planting, urban garden projects, beach and park cleanups, and bench painting at the National Mall.

### Summer Interns Give Back

Across eight markets, 60 Bozzuto interns came together to volunteer for a variety of organizations, including A Wider Circle, Campaign Against Hunger, the Boys and Girls Club, the Greater Chicago Food Depository, and The Greater Boston Food Bank.



### Youth Development: BYOB School **Supply Drive**

Bozzuto hosted a "Build Your Own Backpack" (BYOB) School Supply Drive with The United Way and Boys & Girls Clubs of America. Communities across our company collected supplies that filled nearly 2,000 backpacks for students. More than 180 sites held a backpack school supply drive for their residents. This was one of the most successful companywide initiatives ever.





## Homelessness & Housing: FriendsGiving Back Campaign

Partnering with 14 organizations on a local level, Bozzuto associates and residents participated in a donation drive to help combat poverty. Overall, the campaign impacted more than 23,000 lives with 100+ construction items collected and 27.878 meals donated.

With the support of our Community Champions, Rise has reached new heights. Each champion is applauded for their hard work, but one individual stood out and was recognized at the Bozzuto Management Awards in October 2022. Assistant Property Manager Pea Medina won the Rise for Social Impact award.

Pea represents our New England region and organizes countless drives and volunteer events, always inspiring those around her to make a difference. Over the year, she successfully coordinated an Earth Day outing with 20 volunteers, a "12 days of holiday fun" contest and a school supply drive in support of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater New Haven.

mission of PACT is to champion work life balance and to make a positive impact on the community.

As Bozzuto shifted to hybrid work, our ERGs were able to design and execute both virtual and in-person events. With the ability to have virtual and in-person events, the ERGs were able to increase participation and create a wide range of programming

such as panel discussions, happy hours, educational webinars, and volunteer engagements.

Looking ahead our goal is to expand the reach of ERGs into each market by creating local chapters. We intend to achieve this goal through a focus on allyship and intersectionality within our associates and ERG programming.
